

ACCROBAT BONDING EMULSION

1. PRESENTATION

ACCROBAT is a dilutable concentrate of synthetic resin in aqueous solution. Its great versatility allows it to be used in many fields of activity. It is particularly suitable for modifying hydraulic binders such as cement, lime and plaster.

2. ADVANTAGES

- Strong adhesion on masonry substrates.
- Increases mechanical strength.
- Contributes to the waterproofing of mortars.
- Improves resistance to greases, oil and diluted acids.
- Reduces the effects of shrinkage, chalking, crazing and cracking.
- Avoids the need for stabbing or screening.

3. AREAS OF APPLICATION

- Masonry, plastering, tiling, roofing.
- Substrate types: cement, plaster, wood, stone...
- Bonding, repair, fixative, surfacing, mixing, hardener.

4. INSTRUCTIONS

Substrate preparation:

Substrates must be clean, not frozen, sound, free of dust, compact and prepared in accordance with best industry practices, free of non-adhering parts.

Brush using a wire brush, scrape and/or dust off the substrate. Degrease surfaces and clean thoroughly using **NETT BROSS**.

Application:

Recognition of the substrates remains the responsibility of the applicator.

Moisten dry substrates 24 hours in advance.

Homogenise the undiluted or diluted product completely before use.

The grout or priming coat must be **tacky** before the screed or coating is applied. (*Must not be dry or liquid*). Never use undiluted when applying with a brush or spraying.

Never overdose (bad result).

Average consumption when spraying or applying with a brush: 150 to 250 grams of diluted solution per m².

Dilution example: 1 L of **ACCROBAT**+ 6 L of water = **1 / 6**.

- Colourless after drying.
- Compatible with dyes.
- Does not emit bad odours.
- Contains no mineral chlorine.
- Cleaning of tools with water.
- Non-toxic.
- Non-flammable.

⇒ Plasticizer: 250 ml (one glass) of ACCROBAT per batch to be incorporated in the first bucket of water

- \Rightarrow Bonding of thin screed: Spray or apply with a brush a 1/3 or 4 mixture.
- \Rightarrow Surfacing: Incorporate in the mass 1 / 0 per bag of cement (see EURO NIV HP data sheet 1).
- ⇒ **Façade joint:** Incorporate **1 / 0** per bag of cement.
- ⇒ **Façade coating:** Spray or apply with a brush a **1 / 3** mixture. Incorporate in the mass **1 / 0** per bag of binder.
- \Rightarrow **Ready-to-use coating:** Incorporate in the mass **2** / **0** for 6 bags of ready-to-use coating. (favourably replaces the recommended products 1 L = 1 bag of coating).
- ⇒ **Reconstituted stone:** Incorporate **1 / 0** for 3 parts of crushed stones, 1 part of stone powder and 1 part of cement.
- \Rightarrow On ceiling / whitewash: a mixture of **1** / **6** to fix, harden and paste.
- ⇒ On a smooth and/or non-absorbent substrate: Apply a 1 / 2 priming coat followed by a rendering coat with 0.70 L max. of ACCROBAT for 35 kg of cement.

TILING

- \Rightarrow **Bonding of thin screed:** Spray or apply with a brush **1 / 3** or **4**.
- \Rightarrow Surfacing: Incorporate in the mass **1 / 0** per bag of cement.
- \Rightarrow Strengthener/softener of tile adhesive: 1 / 0 for 25 kg of powder adhesive.

• COVERING

⇒ Bonding on fillets, edges, ridges: Spray or apply with a brush 1 / 5. Incorporate 1 / 2 per bag of binder.

PLASTERING / PAINTING

- ⇒ Strengthener and filler bonding: Incorporate 250 ml (one glass) of ACCROBAT per bag of binder.
- ⇒ Plaster bonding on smooth concrete (formwork beam): Spray or apply with a brush 1 / 1.
- \Rightarrow Plaster bonding (spray or brush application) on:
 - Smooth concrete (formwork beam): 1 / 1.
 - Underside of slab on lintels: 1 / 1.
 - > Wood: 1 / 3.
 - > Surfacing on wooden floors, stairs, screed: 1 / 1.
- \Rightarrow **Powder substrate stabilizer: 1 / 5** mixture before paint.
- ⇒ **Powder roughcast fixative: 1 / 5** mixture before water-based paint.
- ⇒ Wallpaper paste strengthener: Incorporate 250 ml (one glass) of ACCROBAT per bucket of paste of 10 kg.
 - Prevents the peeling and turning of vinyl seams
- ⇒ Filling of cracks on old exterior joinery: Incorporate 250 ml (one glass) of ACCROBAT for 5 kg of coating
- \Rightarrow Fixative, hardener and pasting:
 - Soft, powdery, chalky plasters: **1 / 6**.
 - > Ceilings: **1 / 6**.
 - Whitewashes: 1 / 6.
 - Plasterboards: 1 / 6.

Advantage: Very cost effective, 3 to 4 times cheaper than a conventional fixative.


